Applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

To be considered for an ESL scholarship, you must:

1. Currently be enrolled in 12 or more units at CCSF, including **at least one ESL class**
2. Have completed at least one semester of CCSF ESL courses at level 182 or above
3. Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
4. Complete the application form
5. Attach a copy of your unofficial transcript* to your application
6. Attach a statement explaining why you feel you deserve the scholarship
7. Provide one recommendation letter from a member of the CCSF ESL Faculty, to be emailed to: zgood@ccsf.edu

Important: Previous ESL Scholarship winners are not eligible.

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic achievement and financial need. In addition, community involvement and volunteer work are especially desirable.
